

Call for interest – Coverage as Director On-Call Toronto Birth Centre

The TBC is seeking **midwives** to make themselves **available on-call for the birth centre to cover for the Clinical Director's responsibilities**.

The role and responsibilities

Being available on-call for the TBC involves:

- Maintaining **24/7 availability** to receive any calls to the Director On-Call phone line during the period of coverage
- Following policies, procedures and protocols in place to:
 - Supervise Birth Centre Aides regarding absences, shift changes, illness, testing and return to work; clinical questions; procedural questions
 - Guide midwives in the use of the TBC, including whether un-booked / incompletely booked clients can be approved
 - Receive notice of any significant safety events or clinical incidents
 - Liaise with the Executive Director to report events and outcomes to necessary stakeholders
- Liaising with the Executive Director regarding any issues affecting the facility

Orientation and training will be provided. Midwives in this role receive a **\$60/day stipend** to recognize the on-call commitment and responsibility to the TBC. Coverage is needed for approx. 60 days per year.

Qualifications needed

- Registered with CMO, not in NR or supervision period
- Appointed to TBC's Midwifery staff in Active category, with no conditions, for >24 months
- Holding an excellent understanding of the TBC's vision, core values, Indigenous framework, clinical protocols and organizational structure
- No potential or actual conflict of interest – cannot be a member of TBC's Board of Directors or hold other positions that would influence judgment in the Director On-Call role for TBC
