

## Call for interest – Coverage as Director On-Call Toronto Birth Centre

The TBC is seeking **midwives** to act in the role of **Director On-Call** for periods of on-call coverage in the absence of the **Clinical Director**.

### The role and responsibilities

Being available on-call for the TBC involves:

- Maintaining **24/7 availability** to receive any calls to the Director On-Call phone line during the period of coverage
- Following policies, procedures and protocols in place to:
  - **Supervise Birth Centre Aides** regarding absences, shift changes, illness and return to work; clinical questions; procedural questions
  - **Guide midwives** in the use of the TBC, including approval un-booked / incompletely booked clients
  - **Receive notice** of any significant safety events or clinical incidents
  - **Liase with the Executive Director** to report events and outcomes to necessary stakeholders
- Liaising with the Executive Director regarding any issues affecting the facility

Orientation and training will be provided. Midwives in this role receive a **\$60/day stipend** for days on-call. Coverage is needed for approx. 60 days per year.

### Qualifications

To do this work, midwives must:

- Be registered with CMO, not in New Registrant or supervision period, with no terms, conditions or limitations affecting ability to practice within TBC
- Hold appointment to TBC's Midwifery staff in Active category, with no conditions, for >24 months
- Have an excellent understanding of the TBC's vision, core values, Indigenous Framework, clinical policies and organizational structure
- Not have any potential or actual conflict of interest – cannot be a member of TBC's Board of Directors or hold other positions that would influence judgment in the Director On-Call role
